

“Discontinued trading of Siemens Gamesa shares – your chance to divest”

Over the past weeks and months, we have received inquiries from shareholders who expressed their concerns that Siemens Gamesa shares are no longer traded on the stock exchange and in some cases are shown with a value of 0 Euro in their depot. The reason for this is the delisting of Siemens Gamesa shares from the Spanish stock exchanges in February 2023.

Siemens Energy held 67% of the shares in Siemens Gamesa and conducted a tender offer of €18.05 per share to all other Siemens Gamesa shareholders in 2022. This offer was concluded in mid-December 2022. A majority of shareholders accepted this voluntary tender offer and the subsequent sustained purchase order and today Siemens Energy holds around 98% of Siemens Gamesa shares. From various inquiries to us via email and phone, we know that many shareholders of the remaining 2% were not aware of the tender offer and are now looking for possibilities to divest their shares.

We are pleased to announce that we can now present a way through which the remaining Siemens Gamesa shareholders may divest their shares and be compensated at €18.05 per share.

Your action is required!

An Extraordinary General Shareholders' Meeting (EGM) will be conducted on June 12, 2023 (1st call) / June 13 (2nd call), 2023. In this EGM, a reduction of Siemens Gamesa's share capital is being proposed to the shareholders. If approved by the necessary majority of Siemens Gamesa shareholders other than Siemens Energy, the capital reduction will redeem the shares owned by said shareholders who will be compensated at €18.05 per share.

The compensation of €18.05 for each of your Siemens Gamesa shares will be paid out latest 30 business days after the publication of the approval of the capital reduction.

Important: In case the required threshold is not reached, and the capital reduction is not approved, all shareholders will keep their Siemens Gamesa shares. They will then continue to have a share in their portfolio that is not publicly traded anymore.

If you want to use this opportunity to divest your shares for 18.05 € per share, it is important, that you vote in the EGM and approve of the corresponding agenda item 2, "Examination and approval, if appropriate, of the reduction of the share capital of Siemens Gamesa Renewable Energy, Sociedad Anónima." and specifically of agenda subitem 2.3.

How can you vote on agenda item 2 (specifically on agenda subitem 2.3.) of the 2023 Siemens Gamesa's EGM?

- **Spanish shareholders**, will receive a proxy card (voting card) via mail sent by Siemens Gamesa. Please use this proxy card to participate in the EGM or alternatively use the electronic voting platform available on the Siemens Gamesa corporate website (but not both) as soon as possible. You may also request to or receive from your depository bank the proxy (voting card) or download it from the Siemens Gamesa corporate website.
- **Shareholders outside Spain** are most likely not registered in the Siemens Gamesa share register, but through an intermediary bank. To exercise your vote, you will need to contact your bank as soon as possible and communicate to them your intention to vote and convey your voting instructions.

We want to emphasize that in order to reach the necessary legal thresholds for a successful approval, your participation and your vote in favor of agenda item 2 (specifically of agenda subitem 2.3.) are more important than ever.
